Organisation

Regional Advisory Councils were conceived at the review of the previous Common Fisheries Policy in 2002 with the aim of ensuring greater stakeholder involvement and participation in the policy making processes of fisheries management ("bottom up" approach).

The North Western Waters RAC (NWWRAC) was established on 22nd of September 2005 to provide evidence-based advice to the Commission and the Member States concerned in respect of ICES zones Vb (EC), VIa and VII.

The CFP Regulation currently in force foresees an enhanced advisory role (with increasing influence) for the seven existing ACs + the four to come!
