Regional Advisory Councils were conceived at the review of the previous Common Fisheries Policy in 2002 with the aim of ensuring greater stakeholder involvement and participation in the policy making processes of fisheries management ("bottom up" approach).

The Pelagic RAC (PRAC) was established on the 17th of August 2005 to provide advice to the Commission and the Member States concerned regarding pelagic stocks in all regions except for the Mediterranean and the Baltic Sea. This includes herring, mackerel, horse mackerel, blue whiting and boarfish.
